Tour number 1: The Philharmonie de Paris

Uniting buildings by Christian de Portzamparc and Jean Nouvel, The Philharmonie de Paris is an exceptional ensemble of architecture.

The Philharmonie de Paris brings together two prestigious architects: Christian de Portzamparc for the Cité de la musique, now called Philharmonie 2, and Jean Nouvel for the Philharmonie 1.

Winner of the Pritzker Price in 1994, Portzamparc has for example built the Philharmonie de Luxembourg, the LVMH tower in New York, and the Dance School of the Opéra de Paris in Nanterre, amongst others. Winner of the Pritzker Price in 2008, Nouvel is the architect of numerous landmark buildings including the l'Institut du Monde Arabe, the Fondation Cartier and the Musée du quai Branly in Paris. Each with their own style, together they have managed the challenge of designing an ensemble that includes concert halls, but also multiple spaces dedicated to the work of musicians and to welcoming the public.

Beyond the exceptional quality of its concert spaces and equipment, the Philharmonie de Paris is an exceptional ensemble of architecture within the parc de la Villette by Bernard Tschumi.

Tour number two: Clichy-Batignolles

In the 17th arrondissement of Paris, a new eco-district is being developed on the railway site of Les Batignolles. Spread over 50 ha, this sustainable district combines all the components of a city (offices, private, mid-range mixed and social housing and shops as well as cultural and leisure facilities) in an environment that is made particularly attractive by a 10 ha park.

An exemplary feature of this new district is the strong focus on creativity and architectural diversity, as well as the very demanding requirements for resource conservation and energy saving.

Starting in 2017, the opening of the new Paris Courthouse designed by architect Renzo Piano, and the extension of the metro line 14 and the T3 tram line, will consolidate the site's metropolitan role and add to its appeal.

Tour number 3: Pajol

The SEMAEST has built a pilot test area for sustainable development in the 18th arrondissement. Completed at the end 2013, its focus is on energy efficiency and renewable energy. The inhabitants of this very dense area enjoy green spaces and green infrastructure.

With a budget of € 63 million, this operation preserves the heritage by reusing existing buildings. La Halle houses a youth hostel with 330 beds, a library of 30,000 books, shops, an indoor garden and the largest photovoltaic roof of 3500 square meters. The two old delivery warehouses have been turned into a 20 class middle school (600 students) opened in September 2010 and a 500-student IUT delivered in September 2013. Two new facilities received a sports complex and a 5,000 square meter economic activity center.
